WISE MEN STILL SEEK HIM



We are really getting close to the end of our list of the 45 reasons to worship God. There are only a few more months left. Unfortunately, many in the church think that worship is an option and not a privilege or even part of the Ten Commandments. They replace God with feelings, schedules, laziness, and excuses that make them look ridiculous in the eyes of God and non-Christians as well. Perhaps this a good time to put off the sin that reduces worship to a human entertainment system designed to fit our personal desires.

Perhaps this is a good time to look deep into what God is doing and giving you in worship. Perhaps this is a good time to live worship to the fullest. Let's hit three more reasons and see if you can find a little more inspiration to worship the Holy Trinity.

Reason 41 helps us get a closer reflection of heaven in a world that is flawed to the core. How does one reflect on heaven in worship? You can see a flawless Savior calling you to worship and bringing you into His holiness. "In your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore." (*Psalm 16:11*). "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God Himself will be with them as their God." (*Revelation 21:3*). Worship gives us a view of heaven even though it's a clouded view.





Reason 42 is that in worship, God removes our fears and anxieties. In God's marvelous hands upon us we find our strength in His steadfast love for us. The world seeks to rip, and tear you down to their own advantage. Terrible! Just terrible! But in worship, God places His love and identity upon us. That gives us strength and the power to live each day for His glory in and by His grace. "Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the LORD your God goes with you; He will never leave you nor forsake you." Get. 31:6

The last reason for this month is a renewed Spirit. Come and worship and leave filled with Jesus that comes to you in many a various ways. Psalm 51:10 "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me." God wants worship to renew you in such a way. You then continue to deliver Jesus in many other various ways. All week long you need to be filled back with the Good News of God coming to you.



### The Council had our meeting on 12/14/2022. Here is a Summary of Church operations:

In Mid-December we signed a new I-year lease with The Treehouse preschool. The limitation of I year was necessary because of the "for-profit" status of The Treehouse. They are considering going to a non-profit status 403(b) which may allow for a re-consideration for a new multi-year contract in early 2023. Stay tuned – there are truly good things coming for both The Treehouse and Lakeside Lutheran.

We continue to explore the possibility of having Lakeside become a "Hub" for a partnership with Florida/Georgia district as the LERT (Lutheran Emergency Response Team) base for future emergencies. Our Trustee, Lee Knudsvig is assessing our possibilities for upgrading our facilities to accommodate outreach and need as a go-between in aide to our community and beyond.





Our finances continue to be in good order through the generous Christians and events that prove the Biblical passage in Malachi 3:10<sup>10</sup> Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the LORD Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it. Thank you Bill Meints, Larry Sheldrake and Terri Warner.

There will soon be new Bibles in the Sanctuary Pews - replacing one of the hymnals.

Our Elder board, under Pete Gardner, continues to provide structure and worship guidance to Lakeside. The Elders continue to be our heartfelt outreach to our congregational members and beyond. Upcoming will be brief "Come To Faith" witnesses by congregants at our regular services to share their significant experiences in their faith walks - contact Pastor or Pete to schedule an opportunity to share when Jesus knocked on the door of your life and you let Him in.

We love and appreciate the anonymous donation of the beautiful poinsettias in our round-about. We also have a new Pineapple Palm tree donated to be put in our round-about early next year (to replace the one downed by Hurricane lan).



Finally, We want to thank Diane Emo as she leaves the council for her outstanding ministry as our Council Member-at-Large and moves on to be an inspiration to other Lakeside ministries.

- "Raise The Sign" resulted in a new digital Lakeside Lutheran sign along Tamiami Trail, giving our church greater visibility to thousands of daily passersby.
- Pastor Dahlke celebrated the 30th anniversary of his ordination, with memories and messages from people who knew him then, to new memories and friendships at Lakeside. And, in December, we celebrated 4 years of Pastor serving the congregation at Lakeside Lutheran.
- Hurricane Ian blessed us with the L.E.R.T. (Lutheran Early Response Team) using Lakeside as home base for three weeks while they served our community by clearing trees and debris from over a hundred local residences. Was this a blessing? Yes, it was. Hundreds of people at Lakeside signed up and served people by tending to their properties, packing up their precious belongings, offering gift cards, sharing hugs, delivering fans, cooking meals, and being there, wherever "there" was that day. Our mission and our hearts were entwined with the LERT team in doing Jesus' work. As a result, Lakeside Lutheran has been asked to be a "Focus Hub" for LERT in southwest Florida.
- The Treehouse Preschool celebrated their second year at Lakeside in March, offering Christian childcare and learning to children and families, involving many volunteers from Lakeside, and celebrating Jesus with the little ones each Wednesday in "Kid's Church." (Thank you Ladigoski's!)
