Questions to Identify Your God-Given Talents:

The best way to identify your God-given talents is to spend time thinking about what you do well. Here are some great questions to ask yourself that will lead you in the right direction:

- What's a task or role that comes easily to me?
- What am I good at?
- Where did I excel in school?
- What's something I don't have to work to be good at?
- What do my coworkers compliment me on most often?
- If someone asked my friends, what would they say?

What do I bring to a team?

• What are my biggest character strengths?

St. Peter states that we are gifted as we are so we can serve one another (1 Peter 4:10). Using our gifts for the benefit of others is the right and Godly thing to do!

The words of 2 Corinthians 8:13-14 speak of people sharing in such a way that the needs of all people are met.



YOUR GIFTS ARE UNIQUE (Continued)

The eight principles (below) fit nicely under two umbrellas. The first is the following definition of Christian stewardship that has been used in our church body for a few decades: "Christian stewardship is the free and joyous activity of the child of God and God's family, the church, in managing all of life and life's resources for God's purposes." The second umbrella is "Maturing stewards do the right things for the right reasons and strive for excellence in all they do!" May God bless you and your Biblical Stewardship Principles to form Godpleasing attitudes toward Christian Stewardship.



- I. GOD'S STEWARDS ARE GOD'S STEWARDS. This means that God's stewards are stewards by virtue of creation and recreation in Holy Baptism; therefore, they belong to the Lord.
- II. **GOD'S STEWARDS ARE MANAGERS, NOT OWNERS.** This means that God's stewards have been entrusted with life and life's resources and given the privilege of responsibly and joyfully managing them for Him.
- III. **GOD'S STEWARDS ARE SAINTS AND SINNERS.** This means that God's stewards rejoice in and live out what the Lord has declared them to be through the cross. At the same time His stewards recognize they are sinners who fight sin and its consequences each day.
- IV. GOD'S STEWARDS ARE UNIQUELY SINGULAR, YET PROFOUNDLY PLURAL. This means that God's stewards recognize that their lives are not solo performances but are personal responses to God, lived out within the community of faith to benefit the whole world.
- V. **GOD'S STEWARDS ARE IN THE WORLD BUT NOT OF THE WORLD.** This means that God's stewards recognize that the Lord sets them apart from the world and by the transforming power of the Gospel sends them into the world to live out the Gospel.
- VI. **GOD'S STEWARDS ARE LOVED AND LOVING.** This means that God's stewards recognize that their stewardship flows out of God's act of love for them in Christ which empowers them, in turn, to love others in acts of Christ-like love.
- VII. **GOD'S STEWARDS ARE SERVED AND SERVING.** This means that God's stewards recognize that their stewardship involves a Gospel-powered style of life which is demonstrated in servanthood within all the arenas of life.
- VIII. GOD'S STEWARDS LIVE WITH AN AWARENESS OF THE PRESENT AND FUTURE, OF TIME AND ETERNITY. This means that God's stewards live intentionally in the light of the Lord's eternal purpose while being firmly committed to His rule in the here and now.

The world needs YOU and what YOU have to offer.



Are you joyfully living in Christian fellowship in Christ Jesus? We have been looking at the values of Christian living over the past few months. We have covered truth, outreach and faith. Let's tackle fellowship today. These values take commitment that go with them. Commitment is the difference between worship attenders and congregation members. Commitment leads to deeper and richer transformation by the Holy Spirit.



One of the marks of a healthy congregation are loving relationships wrapped in commitment. In your church home, who would miss your Christian fellowship if you left the congregation today? Many church goers look to see how they can be served and the quality of that service they can receive. The spiritually mature seek to serve others in loving relationships that build, encourage and joyfully inspire others. Worship spots are easy to find - committed loving relationships that are living out the love of Jesus is a whole different thing.

What would happen if you were committed to continually practice committed love for one another in the congregation through table fellowship? The Bible says "But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin." (I John I). The love that a congregation has in Christ is deeper, richer, faster, and more authentic than anywhere else in the world. (John 13:34)

What relationships can you invest in to build the bond of others in faith up to God, in to other Christians, and out to those outside of faith?








Prayer Chain


Helping Hands
