

VISITORS - Thank you for worshiping with us this day and may God bless your time here. We have three types of membership at Lakeside Lutheran Church: Full, Associate and Seasonal. Full Membership consist of those people confirmed in the LCMS faith who live fulltime in the Venice area and consider Lakeside their church home. Associate members are confirmed in the LCMS faith but maintain their membership at their home church. Seasonal members are those who attend and consider Lakeside their church home when they are in the Venice area, but have not been confirmed in an LCMS faith.
